Bereavement Support Group

When do we meet?

We hold a warm and welcoming support group once a month in the evening at the Hospice.

Dates and times are detailed on the next page.

Where do we meet?

The group meets at St Luke's Hospice, Queensway, Winsford.

The venue is easily accessible, with on-site parking and is wheelchair friendly.

Who can attend?

The group is open to all adults in the community affected by bereavement through illness.
There does not need to have been prior involvement with the Hospice. You can self refer or be referred by a healthcare professional.

After 18 months attendees are invited to move to the **Bereavement Support Cafe** for ongoing support, if required.

What happens at the group?

Each group is facilitated by trained counsellors and volunteers.

It is run as a structured session where you are able to meet others in a similar position and in a safe space, creating a sense of belonging which can help with feelings of isolation and which promotes mutual support and encouragement.

On arrival, you will be invited to join a small group of people, wherever possible in a similar situation to your own.

There is a warm welcome, hot drinks and other refreshments.
